The School of Public Health and Health Services (SPHHS) at The George Washington University is seeking a tenured or tenure-eligible candidate to serve as **Professor and Chair of the Department of Global Health**. We are seeking an individual with a strong capacity to inspire, mentor, and enable faculty and students, and to manage the resources, operations, and growth of the Department. The SPHHS is a CEPH-accredited school of public health with rigorous programs of graduate-level education and research across seven departments: Environmental and Occupational Health; Epidemiology and Biostatistics; Exercise Science; Global Health; Health Policy; Health Services Management and Leadership; and Prevention and Community Health.

The Department of Global Health offers exciting and diverse programs of study to prepare students to address today's global health challenges. Masters of Public Health Students can focus their studies in one of several concentrations (global health communication; global health policy; global health program design, monitoring, and evaluation; and global health management) or participate in inter-departmental programs in global health and epidemiology and global health and the environment. The curriculum provides a rigorous foundation in public health principles and methods, examines core global health concepts and policies, and emphasizes interdisciplinary research approaches. The Department offers several joint degree programs, overseas study programs in Bangladesh, China, Ethiopia, and Kenya, and over 30 international fellowship opportunities. The Department also offers a DrPH program. The scope of the department is guided by a multidisciplinary faculty with a broad scope of research in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. Additional scholarly research and policy activities are carried out by the GW Center for Global Health which is closely affiliated with the department.

Basic Qualifications: Applicants must hold a doctoral degree (PhD, MD, ScD, DrPH, or JD) in a discipline related to public health, and have experience in research and education related to global/international health. Applicants must have a demonstrated broad understanding of current issues in global/international health and its interdisciplinary nature. Applicants also must have achievements commensurate with appointment at the level of Professor, including proven accomplishments in education and in scholarship as evidenced by peer-reviewed publications and an established record of research funding.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference will be given to candidates who have: a) demonstrated management and leadership experience related to global health research

and/or education; b) a demonstrated capacity to engage in interdisciplinary scholarship and teaching; and c) experience or skills that will further enable the SPHHS to take strategic advantage of its unique location in Washington, DC.
